

International Wheel Gymnastics Federation Competition Rules 2016

As there seem to be misunderstandings concerning the rules of the All Around and Individual Competitions as well as the number of qualified gymnasts per country in the Individual Finals here are some explanations that will help to understand the Competition Rules 2016 (CR2016).

Juniors:

a) There were **no changes** made in the general rules for the Junior All Around Competition or the Junior Individual Finals (see point 1.2.2 in the CR2016).

b) A maximum of **two gymnasts per country per discipline** can qualify for the Individual Discipline Finals.

c) The minimum qualifying scores for the finals are now the same for Juniors AND Seniors (see point 1.2.3 CR2016).

Straight-line	7.00 points
Spiral	6.00 points
Vault	6.50 points (best of two vaults)

Seniors:

1. Senior Individual Finals

a) There were **no changes** made in the rules **for the Senior Individual Finals.**

b) A maximum of **two gymnasts per country per discipline** can qualify for the Individual Discipline Finals.

c) The minimum qualifying scores for the finals are now the same for Juniors AND Seniors (see point 1.2.3 CR2016).

Straight-line	7.00 points
Spiral	6.00 points
Vault	6.50 points (best of two vaults)



2. NEW - Senior All Around Competition

- a) In the **Senior All Around Competition** there is a qualification round for all senior competitors.
- b) The **six women and six men with the best combined scores** from this qualification **will proceed to the Senior All Around Finals** (see point 1.2.5 CR2016).
- c) There is a **separate Senior All Around Final**
- d) The World All Around Senior Champions (men and women) are decided in the Senior All Around Finals. The World All Around Senior Champion will be the competitor with the highest combined score of the three disciplines, straight-line, spiral and vault.
