Team World Cup

**Date:** Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> April 2019, 13.00 – 16:00

**Location:** Akita Prefectural Gymnasium

**Competition:** The Team World Cup 2019 is a **team competition** to which (in general) the **four best teams from the last World Championships qualify.**

**Participants:** The following teams qualified for the Team World-Cup 2019:

**Team 1: Germany** → **1<sup>st</sup> place WC 2018**  
**Team 2: Switzerland** → **2<sup>nd</sup> place WC 2018**  
**Team 3: Japan** → **3<sup>rd</sup> place WC 2018**  
**Team 4: the Netherlands** → **4<sup>th</sup> place WC 2018**

→ **Per team 1 delegation leader + 1 coach + 2 judges\***  
**\*See extra information on judges**

**Competition Format A**

**A team consists of 4 – 6 gymnasts (juniors and/or seniors) performing the following six disciplines:**

- 2 x straight-line to music
- 2 x spiral
- 1 x vault
- **1 elective routine** (either straight-line to music **OR** spiral **OR** vault)

A gymnast may perform **up to three exercises** – but **maximum** one exercise **per discipline.**

**The current International Code of Points of the IRV applies.**

### **Competition format B:**

- Each team enters its gymnasts in the start list without knowing the order in which the other teams have entered their gymnasts.
- **NEW:** When all the teams have handed in their line-ups, the starting list will be made public for the teams.
- The competition will consist of six rounds. One gymnast per team will compete in each round.
- At the end of each round the gymnasts' scores will decide the order within the round (highest to lowest). The teams will be awarded points on the basis of this order:
  - Winner of the round: 4 points
  - Second place in the round: 3 points
  - Third place in the round: 2 points
  - Fourth place in the round: 1 point
- At the end of six rounds the sum of these points will give the final team scores.
- Each team has the opportunity to nominate **ONE JOKER** at the beginning of **one** of the six rounds. This joker means that the points obtained by the team for that round will be doubled. A joker has to be nominated **BEFORE** the first gymnast starts to compete in a round.
- It is possible for all the teams to nominate their joker in the same round or for the jokers to be nominated in different rounds.
- In the case of a draw between two or more teams, the overall result of the "real" scores (scores given by the judges for each routine) will be used to determine which team places higher.
- If this still does not separate the teams the highest single score achieved by the teams in question is used to determine which team places higher.

### Judges

**The teams Germany, Switzerland and the Netherlands must register two judges. Team Japan must register 5 judges (local organiser)** The judges must not be competitors or have any other official function at the Team World-Cup. All judges must have a national or international judging qualification (written confirmation of judging competence) and must have judging experience **in all three disciplines** at a national or an international level. The IRV Judging Officer will decide which judges to use in the Team World-Cup.

All judges are requested to dress according to the following dress code:

- **Black trousers. NOT jeans!**
- **White shirt/blouse**
- **Black blazer/jacket (no leather)**
- **Tie (men)**
- **Suitable black shoes. NO trainers! NO stilettos!**



## Tickets

Tickets for the Team World-Cup are for **free** (There are over 2,000 seats in the Akita Prefectural Gymnasium).

**Farewell Party:** A Farewell Party with all official delegation members (gymnasts, judges, coaches etc.) and fans etc. will be held after the Team World Cup in the **Akita View Hotel. All official delegation members have free entrance! All other visitors must buy tickets.** Tickets include unlimited free drinks (beer, wine, sake and non alcoholic drinks) and can be bought at hotel reception desk.

## Accommodation

**Important: Hotel accommodation/food** (breakfast and dinner) **will be booked for the four official delegations** (where one official delegation consists of the following persons: 1 delegation leader, 4 gymnasts, 2 judges and 1 coach) **from Friday to Monday, but they will have to pay for themselves!**

If delegations need more rooms **for official delegation members**, please inform the local organisers about the number of additional rooms (see Registration Form/point 9: Additional Rooms). The local organisers will try to book those rooms for you.
